Temperature Taking

- All persons & students entering the building will be subject to temperature checks
- ***By sending your child to school you are certifying that your child is healthy & symptom free. The Bergen County & NJ State guidelines while our cohort is in “ORANGE” is that any child having a symptom of Covid will be subject to quarantine for 14 days or have a negative PCR Covid test after a period of time which will be determined by the school nurse & the BC Health Department (SEE THE LETTER YOU RECEIVED FROM ME THIS WEEK)***

Line-Up & Dismissal
